

Grade 7 Immunization Requirements

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Ohio law mandates children have certain immunizations for school attendance. Before entering the 7th grade, students must have received **1.)** One (1) dose of the **Tdap** (adult vaccine for **T**etanus, **D**iphtheria, and **P**ertussis) and **2.)** One (1) dose of MCV4 Meningococcal vaccine BEFORE the first day of school in August.

You are receiving this letter now so that you may notify me if your child has already received the Tdap and Meningococcal vaccine, or to make arrangements for your child to receive the immunizations.

If your child has already received the vaccines, complete the bottom of this letter and return it to me.

If your child has not already received the vaccines, contact your child's doctor/clinic to schedule an appointment.

The Hamilton County/Butler County Health Department provides the vaccine either free or for a nominal charge. You may reach the Hamilton County Health Department at 946-7882 or the Butler County Health Department at 863-1770 for additional information and their immunization clinic schedule.
