BEAP Directories

****Please note: **** The system will allow you to schedule two teachers at the same time and will indicate to you that the schedules overlap. **You should NOT schedule two teachers for the same time EXCEPT in the case of 6th grade teachers:** Since Ms. Mellea teaches 7th graders as well as 6th graders, the 6th grade teachers' schedules are separate. **You should schedule both 6th grade teachers for the same time slot if you wish to see them both.**

If they re-take the photos, they must return the entire original picture packet **EXCEPT THE CLASS PHOTO**. **The class photo is yours to keep**. They should give the original photo packet to the photographer on re-take day.
