- We are phasing out all styrofoam from the cafeteria. We will be transitioning to biodegradable trays very soon.

- We are no longer able to supply bowls for the students' warmups that are brought from home. **We are asking that you pack a microwave safe dish for you child's food to be warmed up in. We are also asking that students pack reusable silverware in their lunchbox if needed for their lunches.** These items will be sent home with your student every day. We are trying our best to reduce the amount of waste and garbage that is created in the cafeteria.
- We are recycling all milk cartons and other recyclables in the cafeteria. We are also stacking trays at the end of lunch in order to save space in our garbage bags. By doing this, we have already cut the amount of garbage bags we are taking out from the cafeteria every day in half and drastically reduced the amount of garbage we are sending to our landfills every day.
