Summer camp at Procter can be an extension of your Bethany experience! Procter Center is a ministry site of the Diocese of Southern Ohio. Procter has youth camps for children entering 3rd-12th grades and weekend Family Camps for all ages and strives to be a place for all people to play, pray, learn, and grow.

Mornings at camp include a fun, engaging Christian formation program. Rooted in Scripture and guided by the week's theme, formation is led by camp counselors and a Chaplain. In the afternoons, campers have a choice of workshop periods for recreation.
