Academic Dean Bethany School

Position starts: July 1, 2019

Bethany School, the only K-8 Episcopal school in the state of Ohio, is a co-ed day school of over 200 students located in the northwestern suburban village of Glendale outside of Cincinnati, Ohio. Bethany School was founded in 1898 by the Sisters of the Community of the Transfiguration and it continues to have a close connection to the Community and its mission. The school, which resides on part of the 22-acre campus of the Community, is going through an extensive building and campus redesign that is set for completion during the 2020-2021 school year.

Bethany School seeks to hire an Academic Dean for the 2019-2020 school year. This is a newly created position and one that will be focused on the academic life of the students who make up this community.

Responsibilities of the Academic Dean include, but are not limited to:

- Serves as the academic leader of the school.
- Oversees the process of course scheduling.
- Oversees and coordinates the report cards and comments process.
- Curates and coordinates the ongoing process of curriculum oversight.
- Looks for ongoing opportunities to provide professional development opportunities for the faculty.
- Serves as the liaison between the school and the Ohio Department of Education for teachers who are seeking to get and/or renew teacher licensure.
- Oversees the administration of Iowa testing of all students.
- Serves as the point person and coordinator in contact with Princeton School District regarding students with academic needs (IEPs, 504s). Writes and maintains all school "Adjusted Academic Plans."
- Serves as a member of the administrative team.
