Dean of Students Bethany School

Bethany School, the only K-8 Episcopal school in the state of Ohio, is a co-ed day school of over 200 students located in the northwestern suburban village of Glendale outside of Cincinnati, Ohio. Bethany School was founded in 1898 by the Sisters of the Community of the Transfiguration and it continues to have a close connection to the Community and its mission. The school, which resides on part of the 22-acre campus of the Community, is going through an extensive building and campus redesign that is set for completion during the 2020-2021 school year.

Bethany School seeks to hire a Dean of Students for the 2019-2020 school year. This is a newly created position and one that will be focused on the non-academic life of the students who make up this community.

Responsibilities of the Dean of Students include, but are not limited to:

- Coordinates all aspects of student life outside of the classroom.
- Oversees all student leadership opportunities at the school.
- Coordinates support services for students who are struggling with non-academic issues.
- Oversees and coordinates the student discipline system, and is the first line of administrative communication with parents/guardians regarding student discipline.
- Oversees the extracurricular life of students including the Extended Day program.
- Provides leadership and guidance of all areas concerning safety and security of the students and the school.
- Provides counseling support in coordination with the School Chaplain.
- Serves as a member of the administrative team.
